The driver of the truck had no insurance and Dancun said that he will not receive any compensation to replace his vehicle. ## Jesus Film Team Escapes Near Fatal Crash!



**ORPHAN SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM:** When we began rescuing orphans in December of 2004, we formed the Orphan Care Program to provide for all the needs of the orphans. This plan included paying the Kenyan staff stipends as well as budgeting for utilities and the small annual school fees for the elementary age orphans in our care. Since then, of course the numbers of both orphans and staff needs along with all the other requirements and necessities for conducting such a ministry have continued to grow. Therefore, several years ago we implemented the "Multiple Sponsor Plan" to make it easier for people to continue to give \$30 monthly as a sponsor rather than asking for an increase from our sponsors. This last year it cost \$145 per month per orphan to provide as we do. Thanks to a couple of special donors, so far we have been able to pay for the older orphans who qualified to go through High Schools, Trade Schools, Colleges and Universities.
